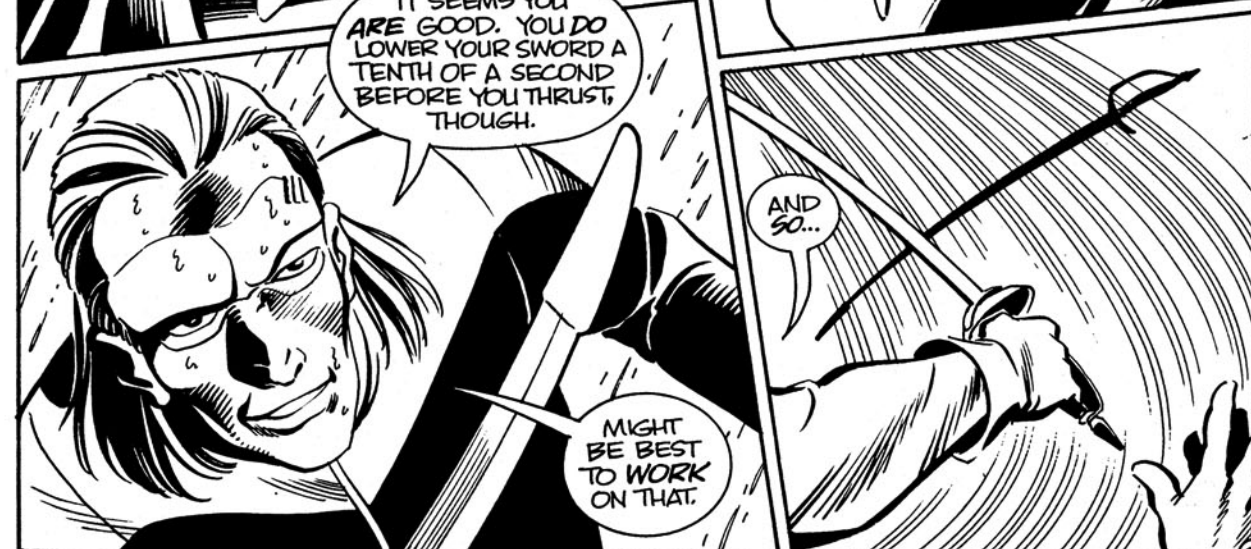
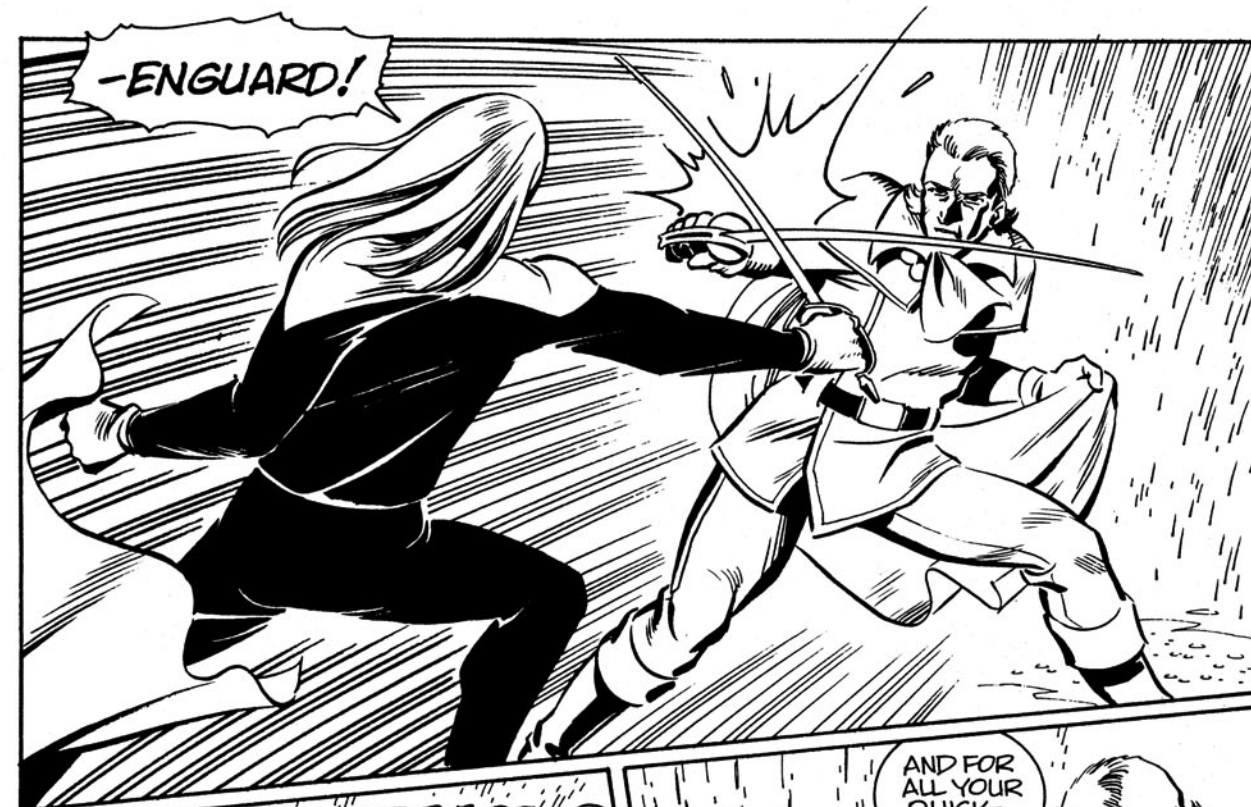


PLANET GOSSKIRK, THE HUNTING RANGE OF LORELEI CABAL.

the story so far

Deathshadow RISING

The plans of Muda and Nevich are revealed, as the rebuilt Deathshadow attacks the Arcadia after luring it to Mars. Because of several factors, including the surprise element and the fact that Tochiro was not aboard the Arcadia during the fight, the Deathshadow defeats the Arcadia and Harlock is feared lost. Daquin sacrifices himself to fool the Illumidas into thinking that Harlock is dead, and Nevich turn against his Illumidas allies and takes total command of the Deathshadow. Harlock, who boarded the Deathshadow during the fight, Tochiro receives a premonition of the Arcadia's plight and he and Emeraldas go searching for it. Meanwhile, the crew of the Arcadia (still thinking that Harlock is dead) decide to give up looking for his body and return to SSX base. Tadashi is particularly upset. Nevich and Harlock put aside their

differences in order to defeat a group of Illumidas ships that try and disable the Deathshadow using failsafe device that the Illumidas equipped the Deathshadow with in case of treachery by Nevich. Just as this battle is won (and the Deathshadow badly damaged), Emeraldas and Tochiro arrive in the Queen Emeraldas and threaten Nevich with yet another space battle. Harlock intercedes, telling Emeraldas that there are better times to fight, and Nevich allows the pirate to board the Queen Emeraldas.

The Deathshadow and Queen Emeraldas part, the former to carry out the rest of Nevich's plan to defeat Muda by himself, and the latter to return to the SSX base to try and locate the Arcadia. Tochiro worries that Harlock is growing obsessed with Nevich and the Arcadia's defeat. His fears appear to be founded; when they do return to the SSX base and the Arcadia and find that the latter is very badly damaged, Harlock

insists that they return to Earth and Nevich before proper repairs are implemented. Meanwhile, Nevich reaches Earth and is tricked by Muda into thinking that the planet's defenses are meager, when in reality there are several fleets of Illumidas ships ready to trap the Deathshadow in Earth orbit where it cannot warp away. Nevich falls nicely into this trap, and finds he has no choice but to the Queen Emeraldas. Harlock seems obsessed with defeating Nevich and orders the ship to burst through the Illumidas fleets to reach Earth. When it appears that Emeraldas is willing to sacrifice herself in order to allow Harlock the chance to even his score with Nevich, Tochiro challenges Harlock to ask himself if his pride is worth her life. Harlock orders the ship turned around to help her. At the same time, Nevich senses their plight and in a similar awakening, turns the Deathshadow around. Activating the Deathshadow's warp field to suicide level,

Nevich destroys the remaining Illumidas ships along with his ship. In a broadcast just before his death, Nevich recognizes that it was foolish to think he could defeat the Illumidas by himself, but that he had always danced alone. The Arcadia limps back to the SSX base.

Christmas SPECIAL

Harlock and his crew arrive on the planet Santa Xavier in order to recruit crew members and pick up supplies to repair the badly damaged Arcadia. Harlock meets a young girl whose grandfather is dying, but the meeting disrupted by a raid by the police force of the planet which is led by a mysterious representative of the Cabal Corporation; he seems intent on learning as much as he can about the pirate and succeeds in stealing an Arcadia boarding pass from one of the newly recruited crew members. Later, Harlock and Dr. Zero seek out the girl and her grandfather, who is an old Solar Federation Admiral whom Harlock served under. Dr. Zero gives both of them a Christmas present by healing the old man as best he can and, in gratitude, they give Harlock a kitten to bring good luck to the Arcadia.

fall of the EMPIRE

As the crew of the Arcadia are repairing the ship at the SSX base, one of the new crew members, Hannibal, finds that life aboard the ship is not going to be what he expected. When Illumidas freighter, Hannibal steals one of the fighter craft and tries to hijack the freighter for his own use. But the freighter itself turns out to be one of the Illumidas on board sets it to self-destruct. Before this can happen, however, Tadashi (whom Hannibal had kidnapped) rescues another Illumidas crew member, Xola who had saved his life. Before the ship destroys itself, Tochiro shows up in a barely-functioning Arcadia and rescues Harlock, Tadashi and Xola (whom Tadashi hides from the rest of the crew).

Tadashi takes the badly wounded Illumidas to Dr. Zero, who is reluctant to treat an enemy of Earth. Tadashi convinces him to help Xola because he senses that this Illumidas is somehow different from the rest of the aliens he has met. Meanwhile, the mysterious Cabal operative who boarded at Santa Xavier continues gathering information and notices the Illumidas on

board. When it appears that the Illumidas might inform Tadashi of something that is not in his company's best interests, the operative attacks and kills the unfortunate Xola. During the attack, it becomes apparent that the spy's body is composed of a metallic material which is impervious to the hand weapons of the crew. To combat this, Tochiro adjusts Harlock's personal weaponry to compensate. The spy then confronts and wounds Kei, leading to a duel with Harlock of abandoning Earth and claims that the company he represents is even now helping the people of Earth rid themselves of the Illumidas. Due to his augmented weaponry, Harlock disposes of the spy. As soon as the Arcadia is repaired, Harlock and his crew return to Earth to see how the resistance is faring. When they arrive, Baron Darghund (who has been helping lead the resistance movement), informs them that the Cabal Corporation did indeed arm the resistance and, with the aid of their mysterious new allies, the people of Earth overthrew the aliens. This leads both Harlock and Darghund to wonder about the true motives of the newcomers and what they really have planned for the people of Earth...
